

How to Make a Modge Podge Treasure Chest

What You Need:

- Wooden Box
- Various Colors of Tissue Paper
- Modge Podge
- Newspaper
- Paintbrush
- Paper Plate (for the Modge Podge)
- Scissors (Optional)



Line your workspace with newspaper - things can get messy with Modge Podge!



Using your hands (or scissors), rip up the tissue paper into pieces of various shapes and sizes. It doesn't have to be perfect! You want about a pile.



Pour some Modge Podge out on to the plate. Modge Podge is like clear glue.



Paint some Modge Podge onto the wooden box.



Stick some of the tissue paper pieces on top of the Modge Podge.



Brush the top of the tissue paper with more Modge Podge to seal it in. Don't worry...Modge Podge dries clear!



Continue the process of sticking on the tissue paper until all sides of the box are covered.



Be careful to not cover any hinges or magnetic enclosures.



When the entire box is covered, let it dry. It is up to you as to how much of the box you cover with tissue paper.



Your treasure chest is ready to fill with treasures!
